AMENDMENT #2 TO CONTRACT # 040220-MES

THIS AMENDMENT is effective upon the date of the last signature below by and between **Sourcewell** and **Municipal Emergency Services Inc.** (Vendor).

Sourcewell awarded Vendor a contract for Firefighting Equipment and Rescue Tools with Related Supplies and Accessories effective May 5, 2020, through May 7, 2024, relating to the provision of services by Vendor to Sourcewell and its Members (Original Agreement).

The parties agree that certain terms within the Original Agreement will be amended and only to the extent as hereunder provided.

IN CONSIDERATION OF the mutual covenants and agreements described in this Amendment, the parties agree as follows:

1. In response to question 29 in Table 6 of the Proposal, the first sentence is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

At this time, MES will not be providing coverage in British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Northwest Territories, and Nunavut.

2. In response to question 42 in Table 8 of the Proposal, the first sentence is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

MES has established a regional office in the Quebec territory of Canada. Our plans include supporting this area as well as neighboring cities for specific products. As our sales grow in this area, MES will identify additional products to offer in Canada.

3. In response to question 46 in Table 9 of the Proposal, the first sentence is deleted it its entirety and replaced with the following:

MES does not have regional technicians in British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Northwest Territories, or Nunavut. If a customer has a need in these areas, MES will offer a solution and the additional cost needed for transportation and other travel costs for the staff needed for training or testing.

4. In response to question 61 in Table 11 of the Proposal, the second sentence is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

We deliver specific products within the Quebec region of Canada. Freight will be reviewed when requested from our Canadian customers to determine if additional costs and expenses are needed to provide materials. If additional freight costs are identified, the cost will be presented to our Canadian customers for approval prior to delivery.

Except as amended by this Amendment, the Original Agreement remains in full force and effect.
